Getting Started

If you are new to Claude, the web interface (claude.ai) or the desktop app is the easiest way to begin.

You can start generating teaching materials immediately with no setup. Claude Code is optional and best suited for users who are comfortable with a terminal environment.

What Claude Can Do for Teaching

Claude can assist with virtually every stage of course material preparation. Below are some of the most common applications for educators.

Content Generation

Claude can draft lecture notes, case study discussions, assignment prompts, and exam questions from a brief description of the topic and learning objectives. It can tailor content to specific student levels (introductory, intermediate, advanced) and align with your pedagogical approach. For example, you might ask Claude

to generate a set of practice problems on exponential smoothing that progress from basic calculation to interpretation of results.

Document Formatting

Using Claude Code, you can generate publication-quality Word documents, Excel spreadsheets with formulas and charts, PowerPoint presentations, and PDF handouts directly from natural language instructions. Claude handles styling, table formatting, page layout, and cross-references, freeing you to focus on content rather than formatting.

Data Analysis & Visualization

Claude can build interactive analysis templates, generate charts and graphs, and create sample datasets for classroom exercises. It supports Python, R, Stata, and Excel, making it adaptable to whatever analytical tools your course uses.

Editing & Refinement

Upload an existing document, and Claude can proofread, restructure, or reformat it. This is particularly useful for converting rough notes into polished handbooks or transforming a set of slides into a written study guide.

Example Workflow

The following illustrates a typical workflow for creating a teaching handbook chapter using Claude.

Step 1

1 Draft the Content

Open Claude (web or desktop) and describe what you need: "Create a teaching module on ARIMA time series forecasting for MBA students. Include an intuitive explanation, step-by-step Stata examples, and three practice problems with solutions."

Step 2

2 Review and Iterate

Claude generates a complete draft. Review it and ask for specific adjustments: "Simplify the explanation of differencing" or "Add a real-world supply chain example using retail demand data." Each revision builds on the previous version.

Step 3

3 Format the Document

Once the content is finalized, ask Claude to produce a formatted Word document, PDF, or PowerPoint. You can specify styling preferences such as font, color scheme, heading hierarchy, and table formatting.

Step 4

4 Generate Supplementary Materials

Ask Claude to create companion materials: an Excel template for students to practice with, a solution key, a grading rubric, or a set of discussion questions for in-class use.

Complementing Quarto & GitHub

If you already use Quarto for document rendering and GitHub for version control, Claude can generate Quarto-compatible markdown (.qmd) files with YAML headers, code chunks, and cross-references. You can also ask Claude to write the R or Python code blocks that Quarto will render, then commit the output to your repository.
